3. Within 20 working days after filing this application with the Stratford District Licensing Agency, the applicant must give public notice of the application in the required form. The notice must be published twice in either the Daily News or the Stratford Press, with not less than 5 days and not more than 10 days between the 2 dates of publication.
4. Within 10 working days after filing this application with the Stratford District Licensing Agency, the applicant must ensure that notice of the application in the required form is attached in a conspicuous place on or adjacent to the site to which the application relates (unless the Secretary of the Stratford District Licensing Agency agrees that it is impracticable or unreasonable to do so).
