This policy is for granting rights to graze areas of road reserve within the district, subject to:

1. The grazing right being offered in the first instance to the adjoining property owner(s).
2. The grazing right being allocated by registration of interest and ballot if the adjoining property owner(s) do not want the right.
3. Public access over the road reserve not being compromised.
4. The right being for a maximum term of five years and able to be cancelled by either party on the giving of three months notice in writing.
5. The holder of the right being responsible for erection and maintenance of fences.
6. The holder of the right meeting the full costs of survey in the event that the position of a legal boundary requires fixing.
7. A one-off charge of \$100.00 being imposed in the case of advertised grazing rights to cover administration costs, such charge to be reviewable every five years.
8. The grazing right being formalised by the attached standard agreement which will be signed by both parties. The standard agreement is to include a sketch plan showing known points/features and the section of road involved.
