DATE CORRECTION: Anzac Wreath Making Workshop

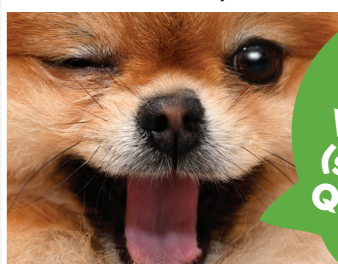
Whoops, we've shared the wrong date for our upcoming Anzac Day Wreath Making event.
